INTRODUCTION

This Astrological Child Report has been designed as a guide for George's parents, with a special commitment: to help with George's growth and cultural upbringing, to emphasize and strengthen his assets, and to alert the parents to mistakes or possible problems that George could face in his life.

Chapter 1 describes George the way he really is (position of the Sun), and the way his personality is expressed (Ascendant sign). Chapters 2 and 3 describe the influences linked to his mother and father respectively, which *does not* mean a description of their personalities, but the way George sees them, experiences them, and which characteristics he takes from each one. In the astrological chart of a brother or sister, the description of parents could be different due to the individual's perspective. Chapter 4 completes the sequence of the description of George's temperament, focusing his mind, his attitude toward education, and his intellectual capacity.

Chapter 5 describes George's destiny, his vocation, his profession, and the probability of success in the material world. In order to get an appropriate view of George's vocational possibilities, it will be necessary to combine what is in this chapter plus what is in Chapter 1 and any other relevant information in the report.

Chapter 6 analyzes the conditions of George's health; some tendencies or possibilities to physical diseases are mentioned, which *does not* mean that George is going to suffer from them, one by one. It does mean that those are his weak points and he is inclined to those possibilities. As a complement, some recommendations for George to have better nutrition are mentioned. *Please consult a physician regarding any physical problems that your child may have. Follow your physician's advice and any medication or therapy that he/she recommends. Astrology should never be used as a substitute for professional medical attention.*

Finally, Chapter 7 describes the astrological influence of the outer planets which affect all the children who were born in the same period of years, producing common ideas and behaviors and subsequent generational characteristics.

It is probable that you may find some contradictions in the report; this is because some planets may be beneficial in a certain area of life while other planets may be less helpful or even harmful. This means that George may have both positive and negative experiences in the same area. You need to draw on your intuition and common sense to come to your own conclusions. But remember that every child, no matter the sign he/she was born in, needs LOVE in order to grow up in the right way.

CHAPTER 1

GENERAL DESCRIPTION OF THE CHILD: ESSENTIAL NATURE AND PERSONALITY, PHYSICAL BODY AND CHILDHOOD

Sun in Cancer:

The Cancer child is very sensitive and moody. He can laugh and cry many times during the same day. George is very perceptive and is fascinated by the world around him, always trying to discover new things. He is attracted to all the colorful images he sees and these images will stay in his mind forever. This child is delicate, gets scared pretty easily, and will probably need a light on at night. His emotional world is vast and he has a great need to give and receive love. At a young age he takes on the role of protector and he usually has pets. He loves to feed them and takes care of them with great dedication and delicacy. Children of Cancer are very good doctors and nurses.

The main influence for George is the home, and he has a special relationship with his mother. He may depend on his parents and brothers or sisters longer than other children might. He can be very shy and sometimes he does not like to be around people. You do not have to force him or compel him to do something. He has a delicate sensitivity and will always remember any bad treatment he has received, which could cause problems or traumas in the future. He is very aware of what is going on around him, so it is very important not to quarrel when he is there, or he could feel guilty about it. Though he is docile, quiet and tender emotionally, it is not easy for him to follow other peoples' rules. He is very individualistic and independent in his way of thinking. George usually gets what he wants and sometimes he is a sort of spoiled child. But if he does not receive the love and tenderness he needs, he could become a rude and lonely person.

He has a bright imagination and it is very probable that he will meet friends of the same kind to play with. He also shows some tendencies towards the arts and creativity in general, especially music. Teachers might complain about his stubbornness or that he is a day-dreamer. Usually when Cancer children get hurt, they keep quiet instead of letting everybody know what happened.

George gathers strength from nature. He would be very happy sowing seeds and watching them grow. He is usually in a good mood and communicates his joy to others. You do not have to worry about his bad moods; they will disappear quickly. He keeps all the things he loves. Even as a grown-up he will still have his toys. This is true also with the things of his heart, including his family, his friends, the neighborhood, the city, etc. He loves to collect things and he is very fond of history. No matter where he lives, he will always keep his memories very fresh. That is why his parents should keep his things, his books, even his own room the same after he leaves home. Only when he feels emotionally complete will he show his authority naturally and become a leader. Girls of Cancer could have a stronger personality than boys of Cancer, and they will be the leaders in their homes. Because a Cancer child develops a deep love for his family, he will always be willing to assist them. All the love he

receives from his parents will work as an investment, as he will give it back to them in larger amounts.

Scorpio Rising Sign:

George's physical body will be strong and solid. All his features will express his strength of character, the look in his eyes will be compelling and nothing will escape his attention. He will possess abundant dynamic energy, so it is very important not to limit his freedom, or try to make him stay in the same place for a long time. He will express his opinions with sincerity and he may say things which bother people around him. He will be very selective about his possessions as well as with his friends; he will never hide his likes and dislikes. His presence will be magnetic and no one will be immune to his attraction. George can sometimes be aggressive and may have bad moods, which will be very difficult to control. His emotions will be very deep and intense; his inner world will never be totally revealed, and sometimes it will be very difficult to understand him. If his parents usually punish him whenever he does not behave properly, he can become a rancorous person and may become even aggressive, especially if he thinks the punishment is unfair. If his Sun (as shown above) is located in Cancer or Pisces, it will reaffirm the strength of his physical body and the expression of his personality. If his Sun is located in Aries, Leo or Sagittarius, he will be invincible.

His childhood is ruled by two planets: Mars and Pluto. These planets are known for their tendency to generate situations of tension, which can help strengthen the temper of the child starting at birth. He is likely to fall and have bruises due to his intrepid and adventurous spirit which causes him to explore and leads him into risky situations. The home environment may be the sight of significant changes in his life, and George can also witness aggressive discussions or arguments between the members of his family, which will make an indelible impression on his unconscious. He may wrongly learn that being sensitive means being weak, and therefore as an adult, he may feel more secure fighting than showing his affection. He is likely to become interested in sexual matters at an early age, so it will be wise to educate him well in this area. Though his aggressive and stubborn temper seems impossible to control, it is not so. George will be very noble, sincere and a good friend to those people who can reach his heart. His promises will be unbreakable, and he expects the same from others. He will have a powerful intuition and will know when somebody is lying. He will be very attracted by the occult and by the mysteries of life in general. As a child George will be attracted to ghost stories. In adolescence he will begin to express his wishes with strong feelings. He has all the qualities to make his life and to be a success on his own.

CHAPTER 2

MATERNAL FIGURE:

EMOTIONS, FEELINGS, CAPACITY TO LOVE AND SHARE

Moon in Capricorn:

George will be a very serious person and shy with his feelings. He seems very adult, as he is so thoughtful and self-controlled; George will show a practical sense and will have many ambitions on the material plane. In the future, he will need an important position in order to feel complete, as he will need recognition. Perfectionist tendencies lead him to be critical of others and he could gain some enemies as a result. This astrological influence gives management ability and some leadership qualities, but it also weakens emotional expressiveness.

Most likely, George will have a strict mother, very traditional and conservative. She will be very efficient, practical, and very exacting. He can be raised in a demanding household, where love is shown through duties and fulfillments. It is very important that his parents show him how to relax and be more demonstrative of his feelings; otherwise, as an adult, he may be very materialistic and will replace his need for affection with money. George will be very responsible and he will be a very good worker. He will be a perfectionist and difficult to please. This child will probably have a problem accepting his own mistakes and/or shortcomings.

Moon in 2nd house:

George will have a great need for emotional security, which will be evident by his desire to possess things. He will hold on to things for a long time, and it will not be easy for him to let go of them. If George is raised in a positive and secure way, he could be generous and a bit of a spendthrift; otherwise he will be selfish and possessive. In his social relationships, he can be very demanding. His future financial situation may suffer from fluctuations or instability; George could make a living working with the public, especially with women.

Moon Square Saturn:

George will probably have some painful experiences during his childhood which will affect the expression of his feelings. George needs sensitivity from his mother to make him feel secure. He may seem shy and very reserved, with a cool and distant facial expression. George could feel very lonely at times, and if he does not learn how to show his feelings, he could experience some solitary periods in the future.

Venus in Virgo:

George will not be as selfish as other children his age, and will express the love he feels by being helpful. He will want to cooperate with everybody, to help, and to be useful. Actually, George will be very shy about showing his love openly, and will do it only around the people he loves. He will be very tidy, critical, and intellectual. George will analyze everything he does and will have difficulty being spontaneous. He also will be very strict with his dietary and hygienic habits. Parents must teach him to love himself and set him free from the inhibitions which keep him from being affectionate. As an adult, George may choose to marry late, and if he does not overcome his inhibitions, he might stay single.

Venus in 9th house:

George will have an intense desire for knowledge and will look for activities which could expand his emotional world. He will be philosophical, religious, and will love to travel. George will probably fall in love abroad or may marry a person from another country. He will have strong intuition and will be a cultured person. George will love to study and expand his general skills, and as a result of this, George will have an urbane, cultivated manner.

Venus Opposition Neptune:

Most likely, George will always be trying to escape from reality. One of his parents may exhibit submissive or evasive behavior, and George will learn from him/her to shelter himself in a fantasy world. His idealism will be great and disappointment may occur in his relationships with friends or lovers. In her emotional insecurity, George can easily play the role of a victim. He must learn to act with courage, facing problems and avoiding escapism, which will only make things worse. If he feels hurt, he may sleep a lot or try to get away from people, instead of showing his pain. In the future, George will look for an idealistic love that will be almost impossible for him to find.

Venus Sextile Saturn:

George will be reserved and will not often show his feelings, but once he falls in love or loves someone, will be very loyal and tender. George will have few friends but they will last a lifetime. He will be attracted to people who care a lot about life, and will feel more comfortable in small groups than large ones. His emotional life will be very stable and George will work hard to overcome any problems in his married life. To George, love is linked to responsibility.

Jupiter in Cancer:

George will develop a great feeling for all the things his heart touches. It is very important that his parents give him love and confidence, so that he can develop the innate sense of

protectiveness that he has for himself and for others. Home, family, and friends will be very important for him. As George grows, he will develop a taste for collecting antiques. The feeling of ownership and of having roots will give him the confidence and security he needs to face problems along his path.

Jupiter in 8th house:

George will know how to handle his money as well as others'; he can excel in management, accounting, or banking. He is likely to receive money and possessions from marriage or inheritance. He will have an intense emotional and sexual life, which could make him act selfishly or irrationally. George will live a very long life.

Jupiter Opposition Pluto:

George can be a dogmatic, fanatic, and arrogant person. He will be impatient and have problems with authority figures. His strong will can make him successful in whatever he chooses, but at the same time, George can have enemies due to his toughness and aggressiveness. Parents must respect his powerful will and must show him how to use it with a gentle touch.

Jupiter Square Uranus:

George will be very rebellious and will not accept the rules or laws he must obey. George will be an enthusiastic, independent, extroverted, and willful child, though he will also be restless, nervous, and untidy. It is very important for him to learn how to concentrate and to channel his energies into only one direction. He must learn to be more moderate, to avoid exaggeration, and to avoid criticism.

Jupiter Trine Saturn:

This astrological influence is a very lucky one, and will bestow George constructive strength and material success. George will be prepared to pursue his goals and to achieve his aims. This condition is strongly influenced by his family tradition. George will be patient, well organized, practical, and very realistic. Though he may not be very enthusiastic about his studies, understanding their importance for his future improve her motivation.

Jupiter Trine Neptune:

George will be spiritual and/or religious and will enjoy helping others unselfishly. His intuition will be remarkable and at an early age George will be attracted to mystical things and to the metaphysical world. He could do well in professions related to education, social welfare, or

creative activity. George will have noble and very strong feelings and will always be concerned about his spiritual evolution.

Neptune in 3rd house:

George will be intuitive and imaginative. He will have to learn to be more focused on his activities, especially on his studies, as he will tend to daydream. Art and literature will be good outlets for his inspiration. Generally, he will feel a lack of understanding from brothers, sisters, and relatives, partly due to his great sensitivity and partly because of his way of living.

CHAPTER 3

PATERNAL FIGURE:

AUTHORITY, POWER, CAPACITY TO ASSUME RESPONSIBILITIES

AND TO DEFEND ONESELF IN LIFE

Sun in 8th house:

It is very important for George to be taught to properly handle money, care for possessions, and to learn to respect the property of others because later in life his career may involve managing or handling finances or possessions of other people. The relationship with his father can be rather tough, with deep disagreements and contrasts, along with, on the other hand, a great need for closeness. Both of them must share their respective ideas in a quiet way, as the two of them can learn a great deal from each other. George will feel very attracted to the mysteries of life and will be a great researcher. He will have great intuitive powers, and will be interested in occult sciences in general. George will live his life in an intense way; his emotions will be very deep and most likely he will be possessive and jealous. The material portion of his life will be favored by inheritance, bequests, marriage or gifts.

Sun Opposition Moon:

Most likely, George will be raised in a home where his parents are very different from one another. His opinions or feelings about them could always conflict, which may affect his inner security. As an adult, George has to attune his personality with his emotional world; George will feel contradictions and will try to compensate for his own mistakes with his mate. His greatest difficulty will be a lack of self-acceptance; that is why parents must be open and not compete for power or undervalue themselves. If this is done, George will learn to know his parents and to accept them the way they are, and as a consequence he will be able to accept himself.

Sun Square Saturn:

George will feel that his choices get little approval and will have a need for greater encouragement, especially by his father. George will need to develop self-esteem and trust in his own potential, otherwise, he can be frustrated in achieving his aspirations as an adult. He will develop a strong feeling of responsibility, which will work as a substitute for any lack of affection. His father must seek to express a warmer, more flexible, and more positive attitude to help George's expression of his personality. This astrological position also shows success late in life.

Saturn in Scorpio:

George will have great will power, energy, and intensity to face life. His personality will be magnetic and he will be very demanding of the people around him, though his behavior will be subtle, persistent, and determined. George will make quite an effort to refrain or restrain his energies; he will not show the intensity of his feelings very easily; his external image will be calm and controlled, but this will not be good for him. George must learn to set his inner pressures free without fear and to express his preferences. Most likely George will not feel comfortable showing his emotions.

Saturn in 11th house:

George will have many friends older than himself and will feel very responsible for them. He will be a very reserved person and will show some difficulties getting close to people and forming intimate relationships; George will have few friends, but he will be very loyal to them all his life. It is very important for him to learn to respect his own wishes and longings and to work to make them real; otherwise, he may underestimate and undervalue himself. The relationship and the degree of interchange of ideas with his father is very important, as this will determine George's ability to get along with others. If George does not have a strong paternal image, he could tend to be lonely and melancholy.

Saturn Trine Neptune:

George will learn a positive ethical and moral standard from his parents. He will also have a very important instinct for self-preservation and will take very good care of his own interests. His great imagination and inspiration will be shown in an organized, practical, and methodical way. George will have a strong sense of reality and discipline will be his philosophy of life. During his life, George will develop strong spiritual and religious principles.

Saturn Sextile Pluto:

George will have strong will power which will allow him to overcome all the frustrations and limitations of his life. He will have vast energy and the power to concentrate and channel it in an organized way. George will not be afraid of challenge and will develop extraordinary self-confidence. He will show a strong sense of responsibility and will usually be tolerant with others, because it will be easy for him to control his emotions.

Mars in Cancer:

George's actions and reactions will always be dependent on his moods. Whenever he feels positive and happy, he will act with confidence. But when he feels down and depressed, he will become irritable and impatient. Most likely George will not show anger and when he gets hurt by someone, he could keep it to himself and then become spiteful. Sometimes his mother

is very domineering so fights with her may arise. In spite of any disharmony, George will be very loyal to his family. In emergency situations, he will show calmness and strength. George must learn to be more tolerant of criticism and to handle his energies with discipline and continuity.

Mars in 8th house

George will be very intrepid, brave, and determined. He will experience every situation intensely and deeply. George will be attracted to risky situations, mystery, and danger, and his great courage will make him fearless. It is very important for George to take care of himself by moderating his habits; otherwise, he could be exposed to risks or accidents all his life. His sexual life will be very important, so he must receive a good education in this matter in order to dispense with taboos and preconceptions. He could also be interested in occult sciences and mysteries in general. He would make an excellent researcher. If George decided to manage other people's money, he could experience some problems or arguments.

Mars Conjunction Jupiter:

George will be an enthusiastic and energetic person, with many ambitions, good health, and good luck. George will trust in his decisions and will always react in a frank, open, and generous way. George's great energy will help him excel in sports or a military career, though he could have the tendency to overdo and, thus, become exhausted. With his courage and restlessness, George will defeat every obstacle in his path.

Mars Opposition Pluto:

George will be a strong, aggressive, dominant, and impatient person. He must learn to control his emotions and how he expresses them and seek to develop politeness and calmness. George will be very jealous with the people he loves, and he will be very possessive and domineering. His selfishness can make him blind, and thus, apt to make impulsive and sometimes destructive decisions. His lack of patience and tolerance could hurt his possibilities for success in his life, so George must learn how to control himself, how to deal with his aggression in a constructive way, and how to channel his dynamic energy in an organized and enduring way.

Mars Square Uranus:

George will have a great capacity for leadership. He will show a great conviction in his ideas and will be a revolutionary. George will never follow in anyone else's footsteps and will resent any limitation on his freedom. His selfishness will cause problems with his friends and it is probable that he will gain some enemies as a result of expressing his ideas tactlessly. If George can learn how to control his temper, he will enjoy more success and happiness in his life.

Mars Trine Saturn:

George will show great ability in directing his energies in an organized and disciplined way; he will know when to move and when to stop. His constructive energy will make him excel in any field of engineering or the military. George will be noble, sincere, and respectful of the rights of others. He will take care of his friends and family and will show great loyalty in his affections.

Mars Trine Neptune:

George will have a great imagination and inspiration which will impel him to action. He could excel in any area which requires creativity, and into which he could channel his emotions. His convictions and spiritual faith will be very solid and deep. Though George could be very emotional and sensitive, he will have much self-control. George must learn how to trust his own intuition and to manifest his ideas in practical and realistic ways.

Uranus in 4th house:

George will have many changes of address and will also have ups- and-downs with his family. His mother will have a very distinctive personality and will be original and independent with her ideas. Generally, he will have unusual ancestors and will have an irregular childhood, possibly being separated from one of his parents or living in a special or uncommon situation. George will not choose a quiet life, so he will often change his residence, job, lover, friends, etc. When mature, he will be interested in astrology and occult sciences.

Pluto in 2nd house:

George will have different sources of income, becoming wealthy from his talent for financial management. He will be a collector of material objects and could treat the people he loves as possessions, trying to dominate them and being extremely jealous. George should learn to be more cautious with his ambitions and less miserly with his finances; otherwise, his economic obsessions could cause problems in his emotional life.

CHAPTER 4

MENTALITY:

INTELLIGENCE, STUDIES, AND CAPACITY FOR COMMUNICATION

Mercury in Cancer:

George's mind will be ruled by his feelings, so he may have some difficulties in being really objective. His thoughts will be very humanitarian and will be attached to his family. He will have a good memory and will cling to everything he has learned during his childhood. George will have a very receptive, intuitive, and sensitive mind. He will have a broad imagination - fantasies and romantic daydreams may keep him from concentrating on his studies. He can show ability and a taste for poetry and music. George could be a bit shy in communicating with others, and may prefer to keep his emotions to himself. His intuitive and emotional mind can make him excel in fields like medicine, psychology, nutrition, or teaching, but he will need encouragement to achieve his educational goals. He must learn to be more disciplined and constant, though parents and teachers should not be very severe or tough with this boy. He is very fearful and will be offended very easily by aggression. Every disagreeable event which affects his sensitivity will be kept in his unconscious, and will have a deep influence on his future. George will be very attached to his possessions and probably he will like to collect objects.

Mercury in 8th house:

His mind will be penetrating and it will be attracted by hidden and mysterious things. He will be very intuitive, reserved, and intriguing. As a child he will like detective and mystery stories in which he will use his own talent to solve the cases. George will have enormous abilities in handling others' financial matters and possessions, and will be a good worker in fields like banking, management, or politics. George will not be very communicative; he will express himself with few words and without openness. He will usually try to keep quiet as he will probably feel that others misunderstand him.

Mercury Opposition Pluto:

George will be very incisive and very aggressive with his opinions. He will tend to be a fanatic and will want to impose his ideas on everybody, sometimes in a subtle way, but other times in an imperative way. He will be attracted by what is hidden and mysterious, but as a child, he should avoid these subjects, so that he does not become obsessed or fixed on them in a detrimental way. George should learn to control his impatience and impulsiveness, to think before talking, and to be respectful of the weaknesses of others.

Mercury Square Uranus:

George will have an alert and active mind. His ideas and thoughts will be atypical, eccentric, and uniquely his own. He will rebel against limitations to his freedom and anything he considers to be an imposition. George will be restless, nervous, arrogant, and very particular about his likings and choices. His opinions will be shocking and unprejudiced, and he will not care what others think of them. Most likely, he will not concentrate on one subject for very long. His restless mind keeps him changing and moving constantly, with the risk of leaving things unfinished. He will enjoy challenging others' ideas and will be very bright and sharp. George must learn to be more relaxed in order to avoid nervous exhaustion.

Aquarius on 3rd house cusp:

George will be very interested in everything that is progressive, different, uncommon, and futuristic. He will be very open and expressive though his ideas could seem extravagant and illogical. His mind will be original and inventive. His ideas will be very future-oriented and will always rebel against demands and duties. He will be very inconstant and restless; he could start studies or projects with enthusiasm, but as time goes by, lose interest. He will travel frequently and George may even reside in another country.

CHAPTER 5

DESTINY: VOCATION, PROFESSION, PROBABILITY OF SUCCESS, AND SOCIAL RECOGNITION

George's destiny will allow him to combine his intelligence with his artistic ability in his professional life. Imagination and idealism will go together. Though George could show some ambition for money, his real goals will be more idealistic. If he works for others, he would never ask for special treatment from his boss; he would obey orders and would never cause any problems with his co-workers. He will show a strong sense of justice and a good memory too. He will pay attention to detail and will be a good observer. George will like communicating with others and will learn different languages very easily. His persuasive power combined with his intelligence will make him a good person to settle arguments peacefully. In order to succeed in his professional field, George will need the support of his loved ones. He could be an easy person to influence and his ideas will not always be well thought out and solid. He should learn to think things through carefully and persevere through difficulties.

His career choice could be one of these professions or a combination of some of them: lawyer, organizer, artistic director, diplomat, public relations, language teacher, clothing designer, artist, specialist in cosmetics, floriculturist, etc., and/or any other activity or profession which involves beauty, harmony, and order.

CHAPTER 6

HEALTH: POTENTIAL PHYSICAL PROBLEMS AND RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DIET & NUTRITION

Sun in Cancer:

Cancer rules the stomach, the diaphragm, the thorax, the pancreas, and the gall bladder. George will have to control his diet, especially the quantity, as he will enjoy eating everything and in large amounts. He will be inclined to suffer health problems with psychosomatic origins. Sometimes doctors will be confused by George's symptoms; this is when his emotional condition should be taken into consideration. His fears, anxieties, insecurities, repressions, and any problems at home will be the main causes of his illnesses, most commonly digestive problems, ulcers, gastritis, etc.

In order to be healthy, George will have to consider the following advice: he will have to have a varied diet, avoiding fried or very oily foods; he will have to avoid eating in excess; he will have to avoid arguments and tensions while eating; he will have to calm his inner anxiety through communication; he will have to practice aerobics, swimming, bicycling, or any other rhythmic activity; he will have to sweat or take steam baths (sauna) in order to clean his pores and eliminate toxins; he will have to listen to soft and relaxing music while eating; he will have to eat green and leafy vegetables with plenty of enzymes which will aid his digestion; he will have to avoid liquids during meals; he will have to practice breathing and relaxation exercises; he will have to be in touch with nature, especially with water.

Saturn in Scorpio:

This astrological position could bring poor peristalsis, constipation, problems in the colon because of inappropriate elimination, stones in the bladder, toxemia, poor or defective development of the testicles or ovaries, problems with the genital organs, troubles in the nasal bones, and afflictions of the throat.

Taurus on 6th house cusp:

The short term problems related to George's health could originate from excess sugar and starch and from the lack of Vitamin E, niacin, niacinamide, Vitamin P, copper, and chromium. This could provoke tonsillitis, angina, inflammation of the glands of the throat, loss of the voice, polyp, muscular pains in the neck.

The best advice, as far as food is concerned, is to avoid sweet things, sodas, ice creams, cakes with whipped cream, and all things containing an excess of sugar. George should eat fresh fruits (of the season) and drink natural juices. The vegetables for this case are: watercress, mushrooms, broccoli, alfalfa, peas, soybeans, brown rice, wheat germ, walnuts, seeds in general, bee pollen, etc.

The long-term problems related to George's health could originate from the lack of amino acids, iron, phosphorus, cobalt, Vitamins B-12 and F. This could provoke colds, illness in the mucous membrane and the sinuses, hernia, bruises, fracture, gall or kidney stones, muscular debilitation, etc.

George could add to his diet: spinach, lentils, beet, broccoli, onion, olives, avocado, and all the vegetables with reddish leaves.
